

Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI)

Leveled Literacy Intervention is a short-term literacy intervention program designed for children who have a reading or writing difficulty or for children who would benefit from supplemental literacy support. The goal is to bring children to grade level achievement. Typically it is used with Kindergarten through to Grade 2 students.

The program consists of 30-minutes daily lessons provided in a small group setting to insure intensive teaching interactions so that children can make accelerated progress.

Lessons include a focus on:

- phonics,
- deep comprehension of texts,
- phrased and fluent reading,
- the development of sound analysis,
- spelling
- early writing strategies.

Our Kindergarten, First, and Second grade teacher have all participated in graduate level training in LLI.
